For local provisions, Roselle Desserts and Blackbird Bakery satisfy your baking needs; Butchers of Distinction is, as the name suggests, Hooked carries the day's fresh catch, and Leslieville Cheese Market reflects a commitment to quality.

Green spaces and dog parks are the heart and soul of Corktown, offering residents a verdant escape from the urban sprawl. Paths wind through this part of the city, inviting joggers, cyclists, and dog walkers to revel in the beauty of nature within the city's confines, including Corktown Commons, Riverdale Park and the multi-purpose trails running along the Don River.

The neighbourhood's commitment to health and wellness is evident in its plethora of fitness centres and leisure activities. Whether it's yoga in the park or a high-intensity workout in a local gym, Corktown offers myriad ways to stay fit. Trendy studios include Lift Corktown, Body & Soul Fitness and RND Athletics.

Farmers' markets, such as the Underpass Market on Thursdays and the vibrant Brickworks on Saturdays, are community staples in Corktown. These markets offer fresh, local produce and serve as social hubs where neighbours meet, chat, and bond over a shared love for quality and sustainability. 
The Malthouse Lofts; Building Insider


This ten-unit condominium townhouse community, artfully carved out of the iconic 19th-century Don Brewery, is a rare testament to architectural reverence and longevity in Toronto. The Lager Brewery building, erected in 1876-1877, was designed by the renowned Toronto architects Smith and Gemmell, whose architectural brilliance is also showcased in local heritage properties like Knox College on Spadina Avenue.


The Malthouse Lofts, enshrined in history and recognized for their heritage value by the City of Toronto Bylaw 1966-0255, retain the soul of their original structure. The building's exterior, a tapestry of red and buff-coloured brickwork, exudes a timeless elegance. Character-defining elements, such as round-headed window openings and detailed brickwork, including pilasters rising to cornice level and intricate corbelling, evoke a sense of 19th-century industrial grace that is envied by many.


Bearing the legacy of the Davies family, prominent figures in 19th-century Toronto, the Lager building's historical significance is twofold. It is likely the oldest remaining brewery structure in Toronto and a symbol of the entrepreneurial spirit of Thomas Davies and his sons, who played pivotal roles in the city's brewing and political landscapes. Strategically positioned at the rear of the lot to utilize the waters of the Don River for brewing and malting, the building's connection to its surroundings is both practical and poetic. The expansion around 1880 with a west wing only added to its imposing stature and functionality.

In 2006, this historical gem was thoughtfully transformed into the Malthouse Lofts. Each unit within this condominium townhouse community blends historical charm, contemporary features, and finishes, offering a unique living experience that pays homage to its storied past. The Malthouse Lofts are residences and a piece of Toronto's rich history, repurposed for a contemporary lifestyle in the city's highly desirable Lower East Side.


