## Everything You Need. Nothing You Don't.

Hidden behind a veil of mature trees and anchored along the protected ravine edge of Cliffcrest, this detached two-storey home is a masterclass in timeless design and intentional living. Built circa 1920, the residence stands as a beautifully preserved Craftsman Revival, lovingly renovated from top to bottom for the way we live today. Set on an exceptional 50 x 250-foot lot, this is a home that doesn't whisper potential—it delivers it. From the street, the classic charm is unmistakable: low-pitched rooflines, tapered square porch columns, and a generous covered front veranda that invites slow mornings and sunset conversations. The exterior's blend of traditional red brick and horizontal siding plays with texture and scale, a subtle nod to Craftsman tradition and its celebration of natural materials and quality workmanship.

Inside, the home opens under 10-foot ceilings, where natural light spills across rich hardwoods and wide-trimmed windows. The main level is both elegant and functional, with distinct yet connected living spaces, custom millwork, a walk-in pantry, a main-floor powder, and—yes—a loveable built-in dog house (we kid you not). At the heart of it all, the farmhouse kitchen brings warmth and soul. Framed by oversized subway tile and pendant lighting, it features a centre island, double sink, and integrated appliances, all overlooking the lush backyard—perfect for cookie bake-offs or impromptu pizza nights. Just off the kitchen, the hardworking mudroom keeps daily life organized, making this space as practical as it is beautiful.

Throughout the home, original character is preserved where it matters—trim, transoms, hardware, and vintage doors—while modern updates quietly enhance everyday living. Upstairs, three bright and serene bedrooms offer a peaceful retreat, including a sun-drenched primary suite, two full-sized washrooms and storage in every room, including a secret children's hideaway cleverly tucked behind a hidden door (we won't spoil the surprise). On the lower level, a fully finished basement offers flexible bonus space with a fourth bedroom and ensuite, a full laundry room with the East End's prettiest door, and an oversized recreation area—ideal for guests, teens, or evenings spent unwinding in your best oversized sweats.


Step outside and you'll discover one of the property's most extraordinary features: a backyard that stretches deep into a ravine-backed landscape. It's a rare, private escape that feels more like a personal park than a backyard with direct access to the trails, where kids roam barefoot, deer and foxes pass through in the early mornings, and dinner parties linger under the stars. Whether you're hosting long-table gatherings, starting a garden, or simply taking in the stillness of a quiet afternoon, this outdoor space is as generous as it gets, my friends.

Set within a warm and welcoming community filled with young families, the home offers walkable access to the highly rated Chine Drive Public School, nearby green spaces, tennis courts, and local shops. And with the GO Train just four minutes away, commuting into the city becomes a breeze.

### Upgrades:

Since taking ownership, the sellers have invested approximately \$580,000 in upgrades to the property. This includes an initial renovation of approximately \$200,000 covering the flooring, kitchen, and bathrooms. A full exterior overhaul—comprising new siding, aluminum, fascia lighting, a porch rebuild, painting, and landscaping—was completed at a cost of roughly \$200,000. The basement was renovated for approximately \$150,000, and the roof was replaced for an estimated \$30,000. These investments reflect a comprehensive effort to modernize and enhance the home's structure, systems, and aesthetic appeal.

### Parking & Drive:


The private driveway comfortably accommodates up to four vehicles, offering a wide, open layout with no physical separation between adjacent driveways—ideal for easy access and flexible parking. 
### Effortless Commute:

Tucked into the lush, lakeside community of Cliffcrest, 148 Scarboro Crescent is part of a hidden gem in Toronto's East End—a neighbourhood defined by privacy, nature, and a community-first spirit.
