A freehold townhome built in 2001, 69 Natalie Place is part of a distinctive Neo-Georgian row, where a red-brick façade and arched transom window evoke Leslieville's late-20th-century design vernacular. Inside, natural light filters from East to West throughout the day, animating a layout designed for both flow and separation of space over 1,600+ square feet. Spread across three above-grade levels, this loveable residence balances practicality with intention, from the connected living and dining rooms to a lower-level suite that flexes between guest quarters, an office, or a cozy family room.

The interiors are clean and contemporary, styled with luxe paint, golden hardwoods, and subtle Scandinavian undertones. The living area, framed by oversized windows, 9-foot ceilings and leafy views, is paired with a dining room that carries seamlessly into a bonus main-floor powder and newly modernized kitchen. Maple cabinetry contrasts with crisp white uppers and stainless appliances, while muntin-style doors and windows extend the space over a sunny, private upper terrace.

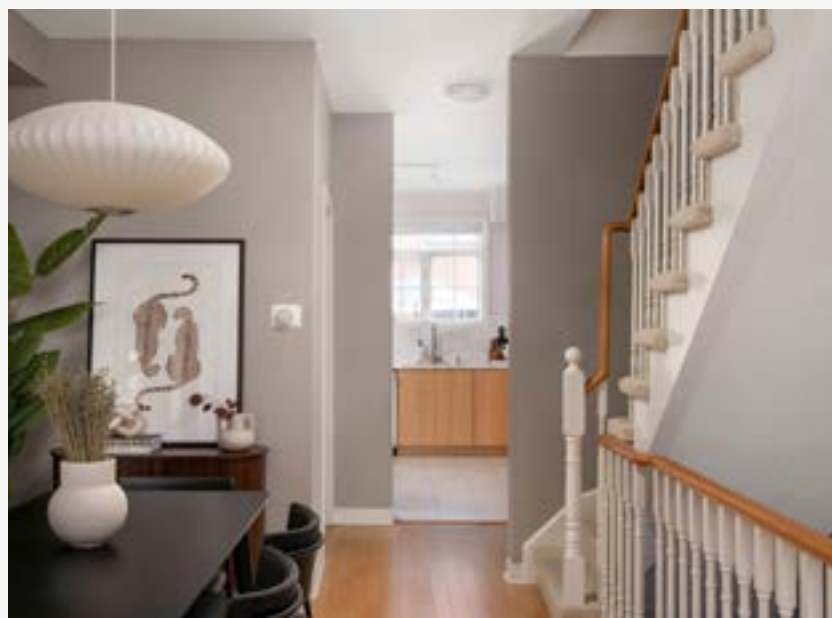
