
A Taste of Nostalgia


This heart-tugger 'Beach-Triangler' effortlessly merges practicality with a hint of Toronto nostalgia. You'll know it when you feel it! 





For a quieter escape, Woodbine Park to the west and the Glen Stewart Ravine to the north provide peaceful settings for hiking, picnicking, or simply enjoying the calm of nature.


But perhaps the neighbourhood's crown jewel is its direct access to Lake Ontario. The four beaches, Woodbine Beach, Kew-Balmy Beach, Scarboro Beach, and Silver Birch Beach, are perfect for sunbathing, swimming, or even a casual walk along the sandy shores. The boardwalk along the shoreline is bustling in warmer months, with runners, dog walkers, and cyclists taking in the fresh lake breeze. The nearby Martin Goodman Trail provides a scenic cycling route, connecting Edgewood to the rest of the waterfront trail system.



The 501 Queen Streetcar runs through the neighbourhood, providing a direct route to downtown.
